INSTRUCTION TO THE CANDIDATE

1. Do not open booklet before time. However, roll number may be written at the specified places on the question booklet and the OMR answer sheet before the start of the examination.
2. In the OMR answer sheet, ten circles marked as 1,2,3...9 and 0 have been provided under every digit of the roll number. Appropriate circles should be shaded to indicate each digit of the roll number as per the numerical value.
3. Write the serial number of the question booklet on the OMR answer sheet at the specified places.
4. Use only black/blue pen for shading the circles.
5. Do not bring any loose paper, written or blank, inside the Examination Hall except the Admit Card without its envelop.
6. Usage of any unfair mean during entrance examination will lead to cancellation of his/her entrance examination.

10. Open the booklet by breaking the paper seal gently. It contains 90 multiple choice questions. Each question consists of 4 alternative choices marked as A, B, C and D. Out of these only one is correct.
11. In the OMR Sheet, there are four circles against each question A, B, C, D. For every question, which the candidate attempts, corresponding circles out of A, B, C or D should be shaded.
12. One and only one out of four circles is to be shaded by the candidate for each question. Leaving all the four circles blank or shading of more than one circle will be taken as an incorrect response for each such question and zero will be award for the same.
13. Partially shaded may be given blank impressions.
14. Use of erasers, blade or fluid etc. to alter the responses is strictly prohibited. This will be taken as an incorrect response to that question.
15. For all the correct responses, one mark each shall be awarded.
16. Separate sheet will not be given for the rough work and only question booklet may be used for any rough work desired by the candidate.
17. The Use of Electronic calculators/mobiles/telephone/cellular is not allowed in the examination hall.
18. There is no negative marking.
19. You are not permitted to leave the examination hall until the end of exam.
